Scripture Reading: Romans 12:1 – 2, The New English Bible (no longer in print)

Therefore, my brothers, I implore you by God's mercy to offer your very selves to him: a living sacrifice, dedicated and fit for his acceptance, the worship offered by mind and heart. Adapt yourselves no longer to the pattern of this present world, but let your minds be remade and your whole nature thus transformed. Then you will be able to discern the will of God and know what is good acceptable and perfect.

Every Christian is blessed with the presence of the Holy Spirit in their heart. We like to grieve the Holy Spirit by not yielding our will to His will. The power of the Holy Spirit is available through the submission of our will, wherein we will experience the peace we desire, and the fruit of the spirit: love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, fidelity, gentleness, and self-control.
