Ministry Operations

The aspirational goal is to utilize approximately 50% of the church's annually contributed funds for outreach. The 2020 budget forecasts that 41% of anticipated contributions will be used for outreach.

The outreach committee feels strongly about verifying the mission statement of each charity we serve and confirm annually that their operations are consistent with their goals and ours. The church/committee is dedicated to the process of hand delivering checks to each charity, when possible, to reflect the heart and caring spirit in Christ of the congregation of Lake Toxaway United Methodist Church.

Our congregation will bi-annually receive a list of charities (see included) that we have served and the contributions to each.

The LTUMC Scholarship Committee (members may be ad hoc) is part of the LTUMC Outreach Committee. The program currently provides fifteen annual scholarships with awards ranging from \$1,500 to \$2,500. Scholarship recipients are interviewed and must meet given requirements: a Rosman High School graduate having a need for financial assistance, provide application and associated required documents, seek to learn a trade, earn a certification or college degree and are recommended by the school's faculty. A list of recipients is tucked into the back of each pew within our church.

Finance Committee Update

Our Finance Committee reports our Staffing expenses and Operating expenses are on track through May 2020. The remainder of our expense budget is for Gifting/Outreach which are generally paid at the end of each quarter. This expense is on track with our plan since the next quarterly payment will be made in June. Our General Contributions, however, are currently well below our planned budget through May 2020.

The Administrative Council approved the use of past years' reserves to supplement General Contributions when developing our 2020 Budget; however, General Contributions are down relative to giving in previous years. Some of this is expected since the pandemic has required services to be limited to less than ten attendees.
